We are committed to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business dealings and are committed to reducing risk of Modern Slavery in our operations and supply chains through implementation of effective systems and controls.

Our Commitment:

Assetlink have zero tolerance of slavery and commit to taking pro-active action that eliminates Modern Slavery practices in our organization and through our supply chain.

As an Organisation, we will:

- Comply with all Modern Slavery legislative requirements. We will describe publicly how we achieve this outcome by publishing an annual Modern Slavery Statement.
- Conduct due diligence risk assessments that identify, prevent, and mitigate slavery risks within our business and our supply chains.
- Set contractual requirements for our suppliers and Service Providers (contractors) to take reasonable steps to identify and address risks.
- Raise awareness of Modern Slavery risks through training and communications.
- Apply a systematic approach to continuously improve our existing processes to tackle Modern Slavery.
- Investigate any identified Modern Slavery breaches and implement corrective action. We will communicate findings to authorities and clients.

As a Team Member, we will all:

- · Participate in Modern Slavery Training.
- Report any suspected cases of Modern Slavery without fear of retribution.
- Comply with this policy and all reasonable requests that progress our Modern Slavery Objectives.
